

Broadband availability

Glossary

100/20 Mbps

The FCC's current broadband benchmark: 100 Mbps download / 20 Mbps upload.

Gigabit

1000 Mbps download service — the top consumer tier.

Fiber

Fiber-to-the-home, generally the fastest and most reliable wired service.
